- Use a permit when the permit holder is no longer entitled to the permit.
- Use, or allow the use of, a permit in a manner inconsistent with the terms and limitations of the permit or TMC 10.30.070.

Violations may result in the immediate revocation of a resident or guest parking permit and, upon conviction, be punishable by a fine set by resolution of the City Council.

I agree to use any parking permit(s) issued to me only on the specific vehicle assigned by the City of Tigard Police Department and only for the purpose for which it was issued. Any parking permit(s) remain the property of the City of Tigard and may be revoked if improper use is demonstrated. I agree to surrender any permit rights to the City if I change residences.

I agree to allow the use of guest parking permit(s) by visitors only and understand that residents may not use a guest parking permit at any time. Restrictions on the maximum days used per vehicle may be part of the Residential Parking Plan.

Permits are valid from July 1st to June 30th and must be renewed each year.
