

SOLICITING AND PETITIONING

HISTORY: The Library Board has adopted a “Postings and Distribution of Materials” policy wherein it states that persons are strictly forbidden from distributing literature, circulating or posting petitions, or soliciting funds in the library building or within 50 feet of the building.

POLICY: To assure that patrons are able to access the Library’s resources and services free of interference and disruption and that Library staff are able to conduct the business of the Library, any soliciting, including, but not limited to, soliciting funds, signatures, petitions, or distribution of materials of any kind, must occur at least 50 feet from the library’s main entrance (beyond the bollards), there can be no chair(s) or table set up, and such activities may not impede access to the building.
