	d)	"Electronic service" means the electronic transmission of a notice of filing by the electronic filing system to the electronic mail (email) address of a party who has consented to electronic service under UTCR 21.100(1). The notice will contain a hyperlink to access a document that was filed electronically for the purpose of accomplishing service.			
2)	Co	The Uniform Electronic Signatures Act, ORS 84.001 to 84.061 is applicable in Tigard Municipal purt.
