TIGARD MAN ARRESTED IN SEX ABUSE INVESTIGATION

A Tigard man is facing several charges in a sexual abuse investigation involving a minor.

Detectives believe Maxwell Floyd, age 27, committed several acts of sexual abuse against an underage girl over the course of several years. The victim, who is known to him, recently disclosed the abuse and Tigard Police detectives began an investigation.

Based on that investigation, Mr. Floyd was indicted by a secret grand jury in Washington County on 9 criminal charges:

- 4 counts of sexual abuse in the first degree
- 2 counts of luring a minor
- 1 count of attempted sexual abuse in the first degree
- 1 count of attempted sexual abuse in the third degree
- 1 count of furnishing alcohol to a minor

After a warrant was issued for his arrest, Mr. Floyd turned himself in at the Tigard Police Department this afternoon (April 25th) and he was taken to the Washington County Jail.

Detectives would like to express their appreciation to the victim in this case for her courage in coming forward.
