UPCOMING DUII & SPEED ENFORCEMENT

Officers with our Traffic Safety Unit will be joining others throughout Oregon for a special enforcement during the holiday season.

From **December 15th** – **January 2nd**, officers will be conducting a high-visibility enforcement for drivers in Tigard who are under the influence or those who are speeding. Both DUII and speed infractions represent dangers on the road that are entirely preventable.

Plan for a Safe Celebration

Always remember to plan ahead when you will be celebrating with alcohol or drugs.

- If you wait until you've been drinking to make a smart decision, you might not. Before you have one drink, designate a sober driver who won't be drinking.
- You have options: designate a sober driver, call a taxi, or use a rideshare service. Getting home safely is always worth it.
- If it's your turn to be the designated driver, take your job seriously and don't drink.
- If you see a drunk driver on the road, call 9-1-1.
- Do you have a friend who is about to drink and drive? Take the keys away and let a sober driver get your friend home safely.
