



Community Focus Group Feedback








- 3 Focus Groups held in 3 different languages in September
- 32 participants in total

Community Focus Group Feedback

- People have a hard time defining where Downtown Tigard is ("is it Main St.?").
- Frequent destinations are Main St., the Post Office, Library, Fanno Creek
 Park/Trail, and the Transit Center.
- Desire for Downtown to be easier to find (attractive landmark/artwork) and to offer more destinations.
- Desire for more character defining elements to Downtown (art, distinct architecture, distinct plantings, etc.).
- Desire for more programming in Downtown (festivals, events, etc.).
- Desire for Downtown to be more safe and walkable.
- Desire for a Community Center and more youth spaces (basketball, tennis, etc.).
- Concerns about parking and traffic congestion.
- Concerns about unhoused populations in Downtown.


