Community members in the City of Tigard recently completed the National Community Survey (NCS).

The NCS is a biennial survey sent to U.S. households, picked at random, on behalf of a city or town. The results help teammates understand the opinions and needs of our community members.

The NCS scores residents' perspectives on ten aspects of a city's livability. The report provides the opinions of a representative sample of 381 Tigard residents collected from May through June 2023. Tigard's results were then compared to a national benchmark score for each question.
