SIGNIFICANT BURGLARY & THEFT ARREST MADE

Tigard patrol officers made a significant arrest Sunday morning, when they took a man into custody who is believed to be linked to at least 10 separate burglary and theft investigations.



Stolen car key fobs recovered.

That man, 30-year-old Trey Huggett from Gresham, is now in jail on 26 criminal charges – most of which are felonies. Investigators believe it's likely he is connected to additional cases as well, and more charges may be pending.

Sunday morning (10/1) around 5AM, Tigard Police officers got information about a stolen car in the 9300 block of SW Maplewood drive. Responding officers found a man, later identified as Huggett, asleep inside the stolen car and recognized him as the suspect in several recent burglary and stolen car cases. He was safely arrested, and officers recovered a stolen handgun, burglary tools and other stolen property, including roughly 100 car key fobs (photo attached). Investigators believe Huggett targeted dealerships and other commercial properties to gain access to the keys.

Huggett was taken to the Washington County Jail on charges including aggravated theft, felon in possession of a weapon, attempting to elude an officer x2, unauthorized use of a motor vehicle x6, burglary x5, theft x3, identity theft, forgery, criminal trespass x2, possession of a stolen vehicle, unlawful entry into a motor vehicle and fraudulent use of a credit card.
