Deadly Shooting Under Investigation

At 12:47 a.m. today, May 7, 2021, Tigard Police were called to a domestic disturbance with a weapon at a home in the 15000 block of SW 79th Avenue. Arriving officers found a man deceased inside the home, who had been shot.

Tigard Police detectives are investigating this shooting and the Washington County District Attorney's Office will be reviewing the case. There is no threat to the public.

At this time, no charges have been filed and the names of those involved are not being released. An update will likely be released on Monday once the autopsy is finished.
