

CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

Fanno Creek Trail Connections Project Begins Ash Ave. to Hall Blvd.

The Fanno Creek Trail Connections Project will construct three new segments of Fanno Creek Trail (Woodard Park to Grant Avenue, Tigard Library to Milton Court, and 85th Avenue to Ki-a-Kuts Bridge) and improve the existing segment from Ash Avenue to Hall Boulevard. Starting May 22, 2024, Fanno Creek Trail behind City Hall, spanning from south of Ash Avenue to Hall Boulevard, will be closed as the contractor begins construction of the City Hall segment. A signed detour will utilize Ash Avenue, Burnham Street, and Hall Boulevard. The trail is currently anticipated to reopen by September 30, 2024, although there is a possibility of the closure extending to December 31, 2024. We appreciate your understanding and cooperation during this improvement project.

The construction contract is being administered by the Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) as a result of partial project funding coming from federal sources. The City of Tigard has been and will remain heavily involved through


project completion.

What the crews will be doing:

- Closing the existing trail where shown in red on the map to the right.
- Constructing trail improvements to this existing segment of trail.

What you can expect:

- Work hours will be Monday-Friday, 7:00 a.m. to
 5:00 p.m. Occasional Saturday work is possible.
- Construction noise during work hours.
- Construction vehicles/equipment accessing the work area.
- Trail closures. Fanno Creek Trail detour to utilize Ash Ave., Burnham St., and Hall Blvd.
