SCHOOL PROPERTY REPEATEDLY BURGLARIZED, POLICE WORKING TO ID SUSPECT

Investigators want to identify a man who they believe has burglarized and attempted to burglarize a school building several times, dating back more than a year.

On several occasions, a man has been caught on surveillance video targeting the Tigard-Tualatin School District Resource Wing on SW Murdock Street, which houses the Caring Closet (clothing for students in need), Family Resource Center and Tigard-Tualatin Virtual Academy.

Specifically, the following reports have been made to Tigard Police:

- On 9/24/24 between 3:15 – 5:30AM a man broke a window, crawled inside the building and stole clothing and shoes.
- On 9/10/24 someone broke a window on a porch.
- On 8/5/24 at 3:20AM a man broke into the building, rummaged through offices and damaged cabinets, then stole various items, including two laptops. In this case, the suspect left the stolen property nearby and it was recovered before the suspect could return.
- On 12/28/23 a man broke into the building and stole speakers.
- On 8/9/23 at 4:45AM someone broke a window and items inside were moved around, but it's unclear whether anything was stolen.

The Tigard-Tualatin School District has added additional security measures, including more motion detectors and other deterrents in an effort to stop this from happening in the future.
