UNCOLLECTIBLE JUDGMENTS) Supplemental Court Rule

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

When certain judgments become uncollectible due to the passage of time or the death of a defendant, the Violations Bureau is hereby authorized to close a file under the following circumstances:

1. Death of defendant: A file may be closed upon receipt of notice of a defendant's death by the following means:
 - a. A copy of a death certificate;
 - b. A copy of a death notice published in a newspaper; or,
 - c. Any other form of proof of death that may be satisfactory to the Bureau.
2. Judgment uncollectible for ten years, provided more than ten years have passed since the entry of judgment and neither the court, any collections agency, nor other judgment assignee has been able to locate defendant or collect the judgment.
3. Parking citations to which there has been no response from defendant for five years or more.
