Tigard Safe Routes to School Success Stories

Walking Wednesdays

@ Templeton and Mary Woodward

Both schools organize a monthly walk and bike to school day. Park and walk locations allow families to meet about a half mile away and walk or bike to school together.

Pedestrian Safety Education @ C.F. Tigard

All 3rd graders will learn pedestrian safety skills and how to walk safely on sidewalks and cross streets.

Bicycle Safety Education

All 5th graders learn bicycle handling and traffic skills to reduce barriers for safely getting to and from school, as well as traveling around their neighborhoods.
